



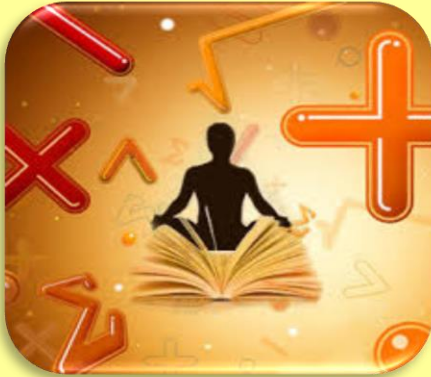

What is Vedic Mathematics?

"Vedic Mathematics", based on a book written by Sri Bharati Tirtha Maharaja, contains many useful techniques for fast mental arithmetic calculations. These techniques use the way the mind naturally works and are therefore a great help in directing the student to the appropriate method of solution.

Why Vedic Mathematics?

The simplicity of Vedic Mathematics means that calculations can be carried out mentally (though the methods can also be written down). There are many advantages in using a flexible, mental system. Students can invent their own methods; they are not limited to the one 'correct' method. This leads to more creative, interested and intelligent pupils.

What will be covered?

There will be parallel sessions for different grade levels. For the 7th/8th graders, new topics including fractions, algebra, and geometry will be covered.
